

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(SOUTH LEIGH PARISH) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (South Leigh Parish) (30 Mph Speed Limit) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the roads specified in the schedule to this order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
4. The Oxfordshire County Council (South Leigh Parish) (Restricted Roads) Order 2001 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

The whole length of every road in South Leigh extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Chapel Road	a point 938 metres northwest of its junction with Church End.
b)	Stanton Harcourt Road	a point 810 metres southeast of its junction with the unnamed road running north-eastwards to Barnard Gate.
c)	The unnamed road running north-eastwards to Barnard Gate	a point 10 metres northeast of its junction with Station Road / Stanton Harcourt Road.
